MASTERWORKS CONCERT SERIES

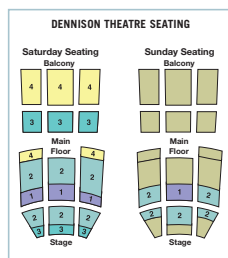
